Did you know that the Bible is a collection of 66 books? Yes, it is!

Those books are divided into two parts called “testaments”: The Old Testament has 39 books. The New Testament has 27 books.

The Bible was written by over 40 different writers who were inspired by God to write the instructions, stories, laws, and prophecies over more than 1,500 years.* Each one of these books has something amazing for us to discover.

The New Testament tells us the true stories of Jesus Christ: how He was born, escaped from an angry king, how He taught the people, healed the sick, did miracles and much more. These books also teach us about how Jesus died on the cross, rose again, went to heaven and is coming back again.

The New Testament has letters written from prison and prophecies of what will happen soon. It is the continuation of the true stories of the real God who rescues His people and you and me!
