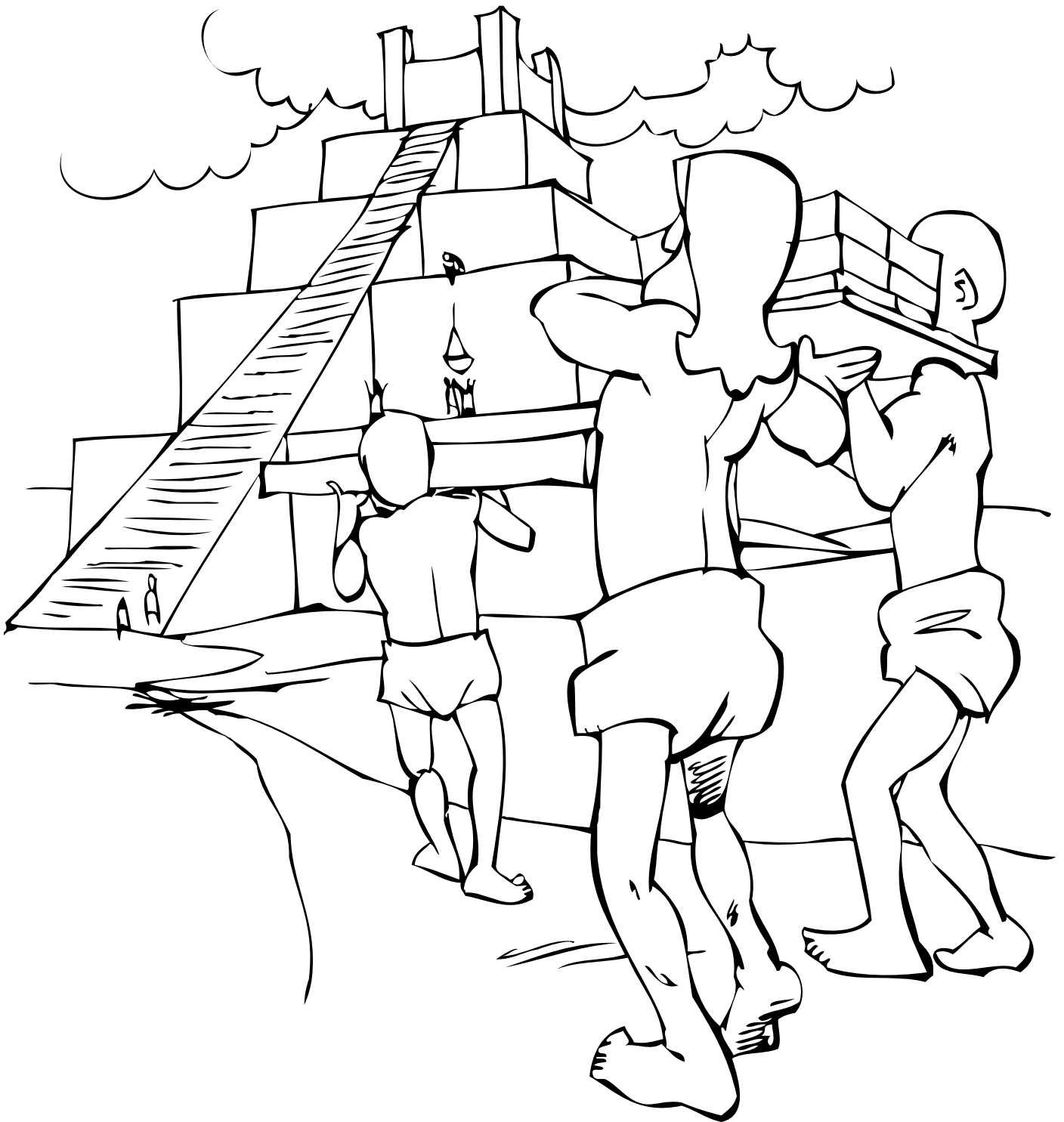

“Hey! Let’s make bricks to build a city and a tall tower so we’ll be famous,” said the people. “We can stay there together.”

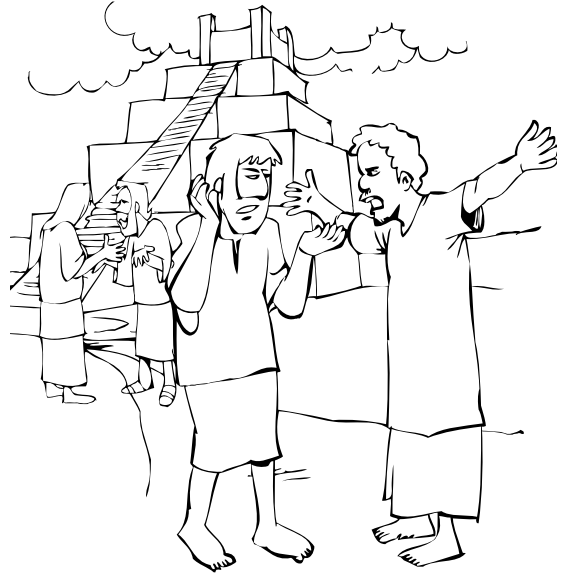
After Noah’s Flood, God told the people to multiply and spread out over the earth to fill it up again, but they didn’t want to do what He said.

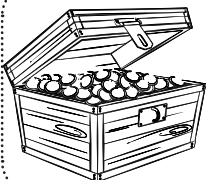
