“Oh no! They know what I’ve done!” cried Moses as he ran for the desert.

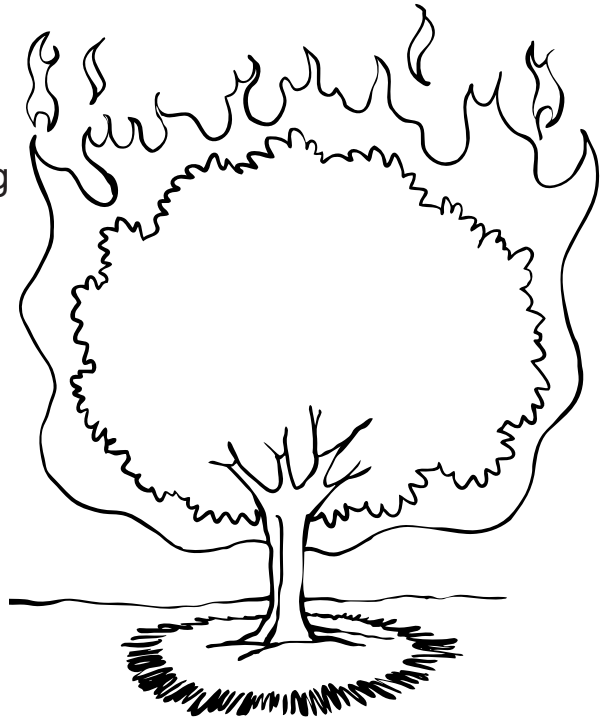
He had wanted to help one of his Israelite brothers by killing an Egyptian who was hurting him, but now Moses was in trouble. So he ran.

Moses thought he couldn’t do it, but God promised to be with him and teach him what to do. Moses obeyed God and headed back to Egypt.

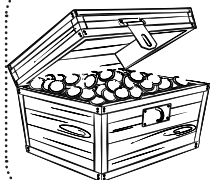
