Moses and Pharaoh

"God says, 'Let my people go!'," Moses told Pharaoh, the king of Egypt.

- (6) Painful sores broke out on the Egyptians and their animals.
- (7) Hail and fire fell from the sky and destroyed the plants and crops.
- (8) Bugs, called locusts, ate all the green plants.
- (9) It was dark for three days--really dark! But the Israelites had light!
- (10) The firstborn sons of the Egyptians died. It was horrible.

Finally, Pharaoh gave up and said. "Go, all of you. Go and worship God."

That night the Israelites got ready and together, they left Egypt, free at last!

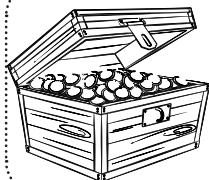
