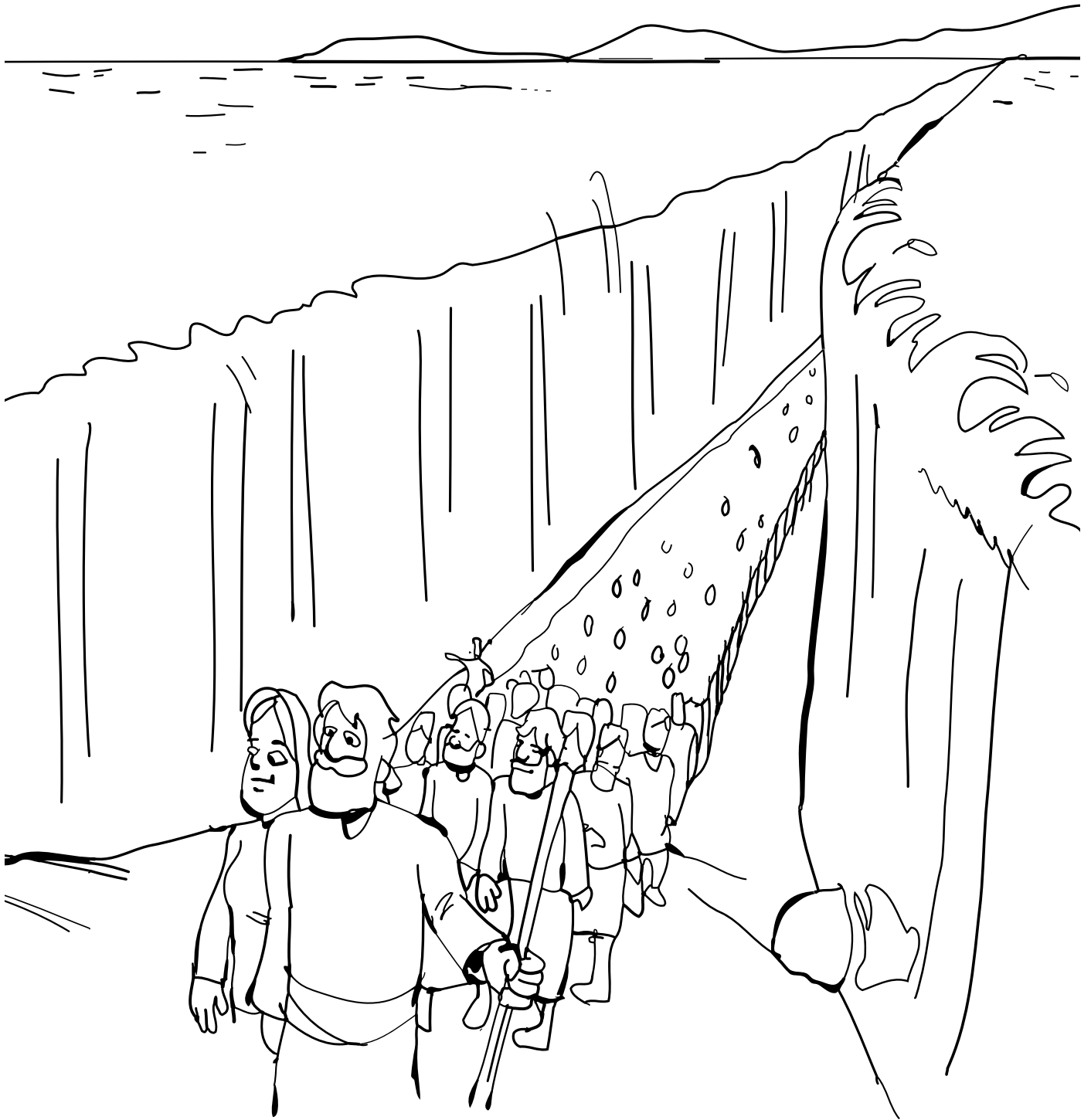

"Let's go get our slaves back!" said the Egyptians as they hooked up their horses to the chariots.

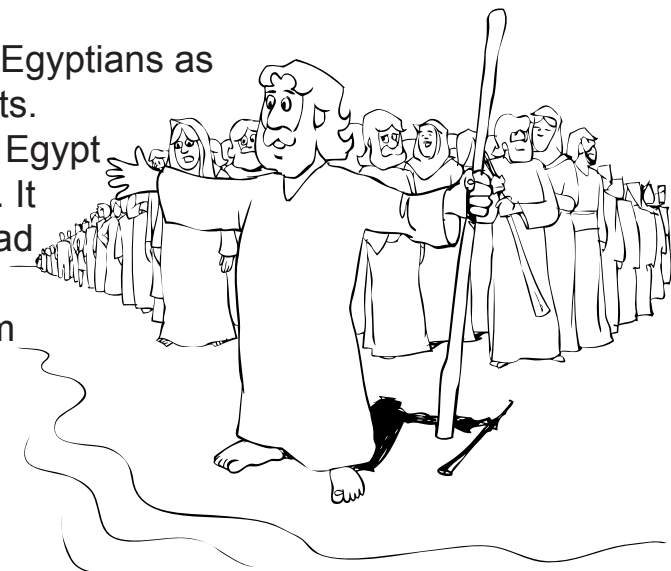
Moses and the people of Israel had left Egypt and camped on the edge of the Red Sea. It looked like they were trapped, but God had a plan.

When the Egyptians saw this, they chased after them until the wheels fell off their chariots and the waters crashed over them. The Israelites were safe and free! God had saved them!

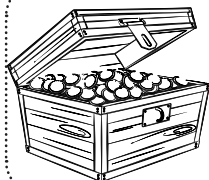
