Psalm 23

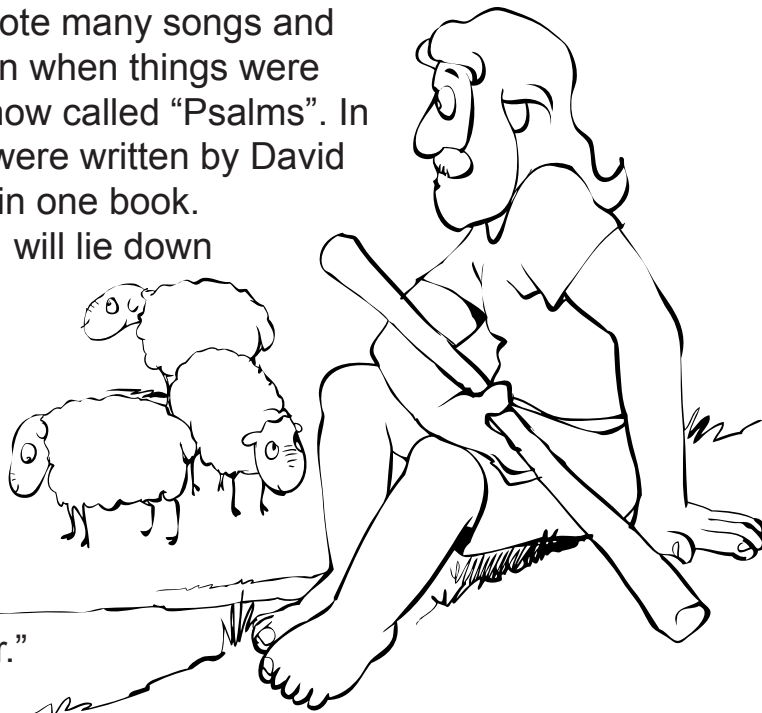
“God’s love lasts forever,” sang David while playing his harp.

Before he was a warrior or king, David was a shepherd. He was also a musician. David enjoyed singing to God. He wrote many songs and prayers about God’s faithfulness even when things were hard. These songs and prayers are now called “Psalms”. In the Bible there are 150 of them that were written by David and other people and then collected in one book.

David sang praises like: “In peace I will lie down and sleep, for you alone, Lord, make me dwell in safety.” (Psalm 4:8, NIV).

“The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing...”, says one of the famous Psalms. “. . . He guides me along the right paths for his name’s sake . . . your goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.”

(Psalm 23, NIV).



Some of the songs that David wrote are still sung to praise God today. They are beautiful and show an understanding of God and His love.

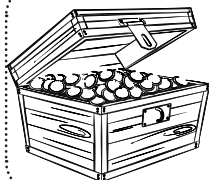
If you open a Bible in the middle, you can find the Psalms that are written there and read them yourself!
