

Lots of people had come out to the Jordan River to repent and be baptized by John the Baptist, but he was surprised when Jesus came and asked to be baptized too.


At first, John didn't want to baptize Jesus because he knew that Jesus was the Lamb of God, the promised Messiah. Jesus didn't need to repent of any sins.


