"Let's go relax," Jesus told His disciples.

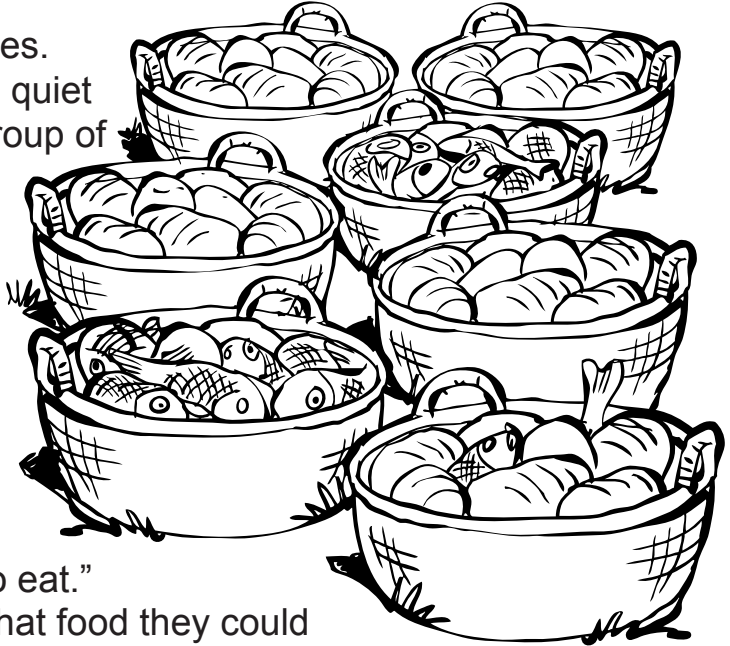
They got in a boat and sailed out to a quiet place, but when they got there, a big group of people were already waiting for Jesus.

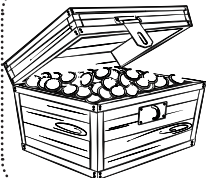
