“No! The kids might bother Jesus,” said the disciples when some parents tried bringing their kids to meet Jesus.

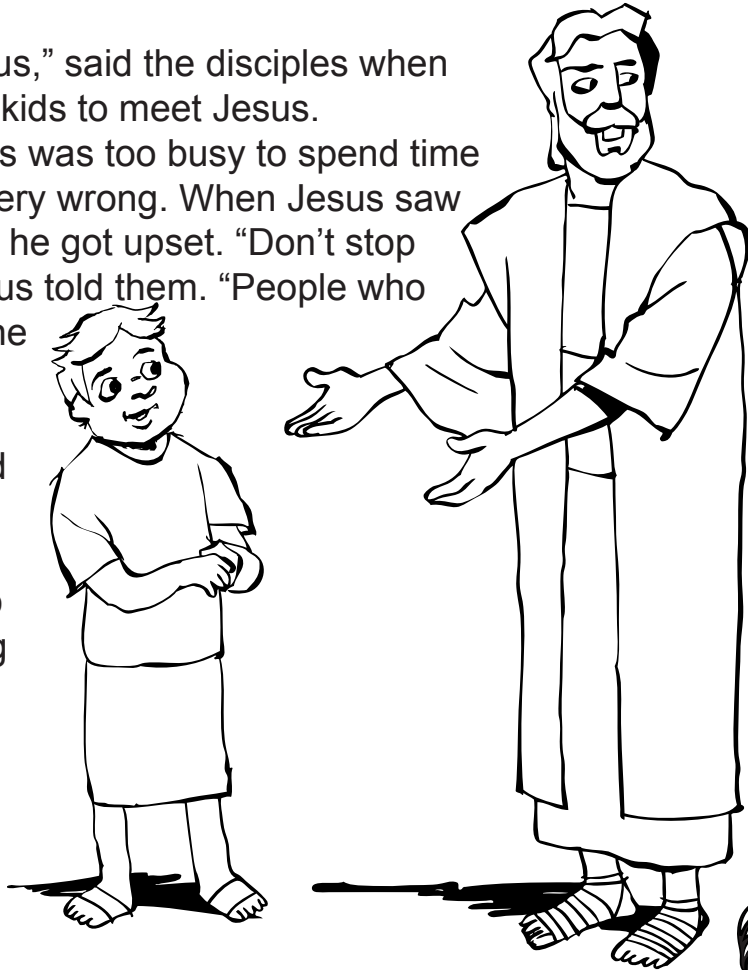

Boys and girls can trust that Jesus loves them very much. He wants them to be with Him.

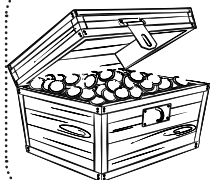
