The disciples found the donkey just like Jesus had told them. They brought the animal and put their coats on the donkey and Jesus sat on it.

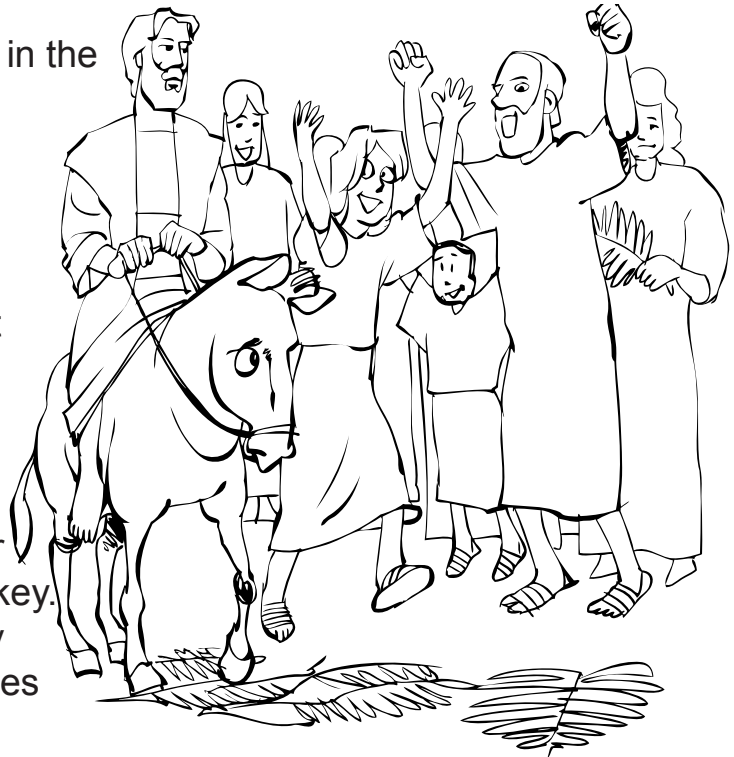
As Jesus rode the donkey into Jerusalem, the people crowded the road waving branches and putting their coats on the ground in front of the donkey.

All this was what the prophet Zacariah had prophesied would happen years before it happened. (You can read about that in your Bible in Zacariah 9:9)

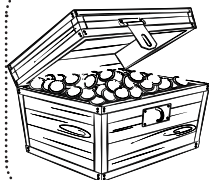
