


The Crucified King

Matthew 27:33-56, Mark 15:24-41 Luke 23:33-49, John 19:17-37, Isaiah 52:14

"Crucify Him!" yelled the people.

Pilate, the Roman Governor, didn't want to condemn an innocent man, but the people were getting out of control. Pilate tried to let Jesus go free, but the people got even more wild. So, even though Jesus didn't do any wrong, Pilate gave permission to kill Jesus on the cross.

The soldiers whipped Jesus until He looked like a bleeding mess. They put a crown of thorns on His head and had Him carry a cross through the streets of Jerusalem. Then they led Him to a hill outside of the city. There they nailed Him to the cross between two thieves.



Many people mocked Jesus, but Jesus asked God to forgive them all.
