
## **Flames of Fire**

Acts 2

"What does all this mean?" asked the people.

Fifty days after the Passover Feast, the

disciples where waiting in Jerusalem just like Jesus told them to. For ten days they had been praying



Outside of the house, there were visitors in Jerusalem from many different countries. These visitors were surprised to hear the disciples speaking languages they knew from their own countries. They understood the disciples were saying wonderful things as they worshipped God in other languages.

They asked what all this meant, but others laughed at the disciples and said they were drunk. Then Peter got up and spoke to the crowd. He was bold and the Holy Spirit helped him explain how Jesus, the Messiah, was crucified to save everyone.
