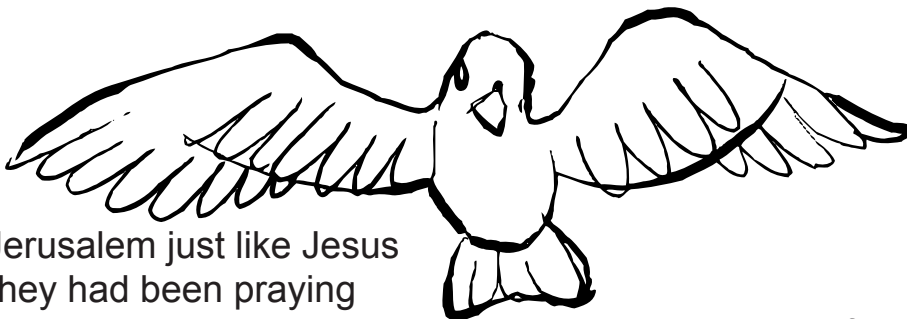

Fifty days after the Passover Feast, the disciples were waiting in Jerusalem just like Jesus told them to. For ten days they had been praying together. That day, they heard a sound like a strong, blowing wind. The sound filled the room and flames of fire settled over each one of them. Then they began to speak, but they were speaking in different languages. The Holy Spirit was giving them special boldness and power!



Outside of the house, there were visitors in Jerusalem from many different countries. These visitors were surprised to hear the disciples speaking languages they knew from their own countries. They understood the disciples were saying wonderful things as they worshipped God in other languages.

They asked what all this meant, but others laughed at the disciples and said they were drunk. Then Peter got up and spoke to the crowd. He was bold and the Holy Spirit helped him explain how Jesus, the Messiah, was crucified to save everyone.

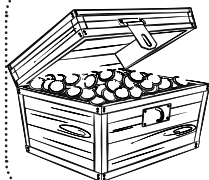
