Acts 13-20

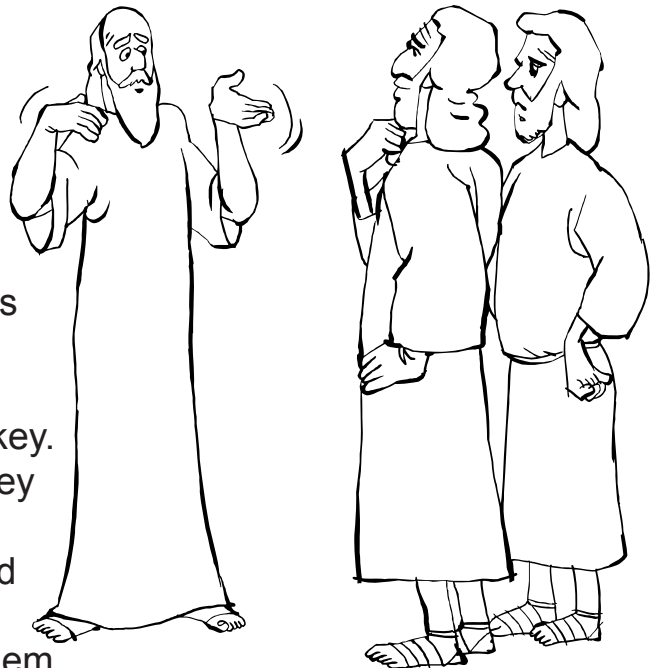
"Set Barnabas and Saul apart for Me," said the Holy Spirit.

Saul was the one who used to hurt and arrest Christians, but God had changed his heart. Now Saul followed Jesus too. He was now a different man, so he changed his name to Paul.

Paul and Barnabas traveled from Antioch and went through the land we now call Turkey. They preached about Jesus everywhere they found people willing to listen.

It was hard. Sometimes people mistreated them, others didn't accept their message about Jesus, but the Holy Spirit was with them and helped them. With the people who listened and followed Jesus, they started churches--not buildings, but groups of people who followed Jesus and learned together.

When Paul and Barnabas returned to Jerusalem, they shared with other Christians what God had done. Later on, Paul made other missionary journeys to encourage those new churches and help others follow Christ.

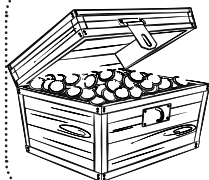
