"You're right, Samuel," responded Mom. "We don't have soap that's strong enough for that. Not even bleach will work to wash away sins. We need something much more powerful!"

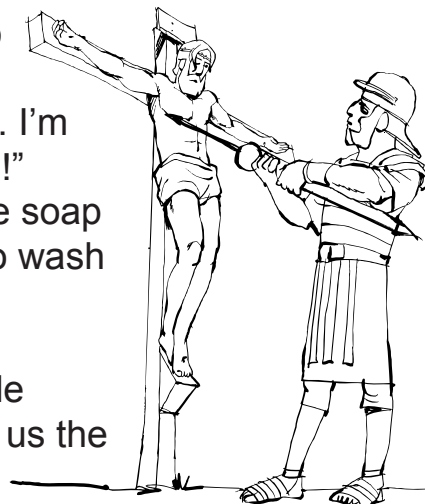
"What is it then?" asked Samuel. "Where can I get it?"

"There's just one thing that works," said Mom. "The Bible says the blood of Jesus washes away our sins and gives us the opportunity to serve Him with our lives."

"Where do I find Jesus' blood?" he asked.

"We 'wash' with Jesus blood by following these steps: 1) ADMIT that we are sinners and we need to be washed from sin. 2) BELIEVE in our heart that Jesus died on the cross in our place, and He rose to life again on the third day. 3) CONFESS (that means to say it with our heart and voice) that Jesus is our Lord or the boss and owner of our lives. 4) GROW the way God wants us to. We should get to know God's Word (the Bible), spend time talking with Him (prayer) and get to know others who want to follow God too.

"I want Jesus' blood to wash me of my sins!" said Samuel.

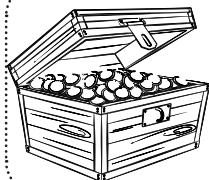
